



**F. DATE TO CANCEL**

**G. REFUND INFORMATION**

The student has a right to a full refund of all charges less the amount of \$155.00 for the registration fee if he/she cancels this agreement on the first day of instruction, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. In addition, a student may withdraw from the course after instruction has begun and receive a pro rata refund for the unused portion of the tuition if the student has completed 60% or less of the course less the registration fee, cost of book(s) and uniform. Refer to the following computations to determine the amount of refund owed to you.

For example: The student completes 50 hours of a 180 hours CNA course and paid \$1,176.00 tuition, the student is entitled to a refund of \$849.30.

If the school cancels or discontinues a course or educational program, the school will make a full refund of all charges. Refunds will be paid within 30 days of cancellation or withdrawal.

If the student obtains a loan to pay for the educational program, the student will have the responsibility to repay the full amount of the loan plus interest, less the amount of any refund.

If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of the moneys not paid from federal student financial aid program funds.

If a student is eligible for a loan guaranteed by the federal or state government and the student defaults on the loan, both of the following may occur:

- (1) The federal or state government or a loan guarantee agency may take action against the student, including applying any income tax refund to which the person is entitled to reduce the balance owed on the loan.
- (2) The student may not be eligible for any other federal student financial aid at another institution or other government assistance until the loan is repaid.
