- F. **STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL**
The student has the rights to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later, but not including the registration fee, book fee and uniform fee. A student may not cancel by telephoning the school or not attending the class. After the end of cancellation period, the student also has the right to stop school at any time; and has the right to receive a pro rata refund if the student has completed 60 percent or less of the program less the registration fee, cost of book(s) and uniform. The refund is to be paid within 30 days after the cancellation date.

H. REFUND INFORMATION

The student has the rights to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later, but not including the registration fee, book fee and uniform fee. The student has a right to a full refund of all charges less the amount of \$155.00 for the registration fee if he/she cancels this agreement on the first day of instruction, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later. In addition, a student may withdraw from the course after instruction has begun and receive a pro rata refund for the unused portion of the tuition if the student has completed 60% or less of the course less the registration fee, cost of book(s) and uniform. Refer to the following computations to determine the amount of refund owed to you.

For example: The student completes 50 hours of a 150 hours CNA course and paid \$ 1,100.00 tuition, the student is entitled to a refund of \$794.44.

O. NOTICE CONCERNING TRANSFERABILITY OF CREDITS AND CREDENTIALS EARNED AT OUR INSTITUTION

The transferability of credits you earn at International School of Nursing is at the complete discretion of an institution to which you may seek to transfer. Acceptance of the certificate you earn in **Nursing Assistant Training Program** is also at the complete discretion of the institution to which you may seek to transfer. If the certificate that you earn at this institution is not accepted at the institution to which you seek to transfer, you may be required to repeat some or all of your coursework at that institution. For this reason you should make certain that your attendance at this institution will meet your educational goals. This may include contacting an institution to which you may seek to transfer after attending International School of Nursing to determine if your certificate will transfer.

- P.** International School of Nursing does not offer a distance educational program.

Q. The State of California created the Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) to relieve or mitigate economic losses suffered by students in educational programs who are California residents, or are enrolled in a residency program attending certain schools regulated by the Bureau for Private Postsecondary Education.

You must pay the state-imposed fee for the Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) if all of the following applies to you:

1. You are a student in an educational program, who is a California resident, or are enrolled in a residency program, and prepay all part of your tuition either by cash, guaranteed student loans, or personal loans, and
2. Your total charges are not paid by any third-party payer such as an employer, government program or other payer unless you have a separate agreement to repay the third party.

You are not eligible for protection from the STRF and you are not required to pay the STRF assessment, if either of the following applies:

1. You are not a California resident, or are not enrolled in a residency program, or
2. Your total charges are paid by a third party, such as employer, government program or other payer, and you have no separate agreement to repay the third party.

You may be eligible for STRF if you are a California resident or are enrolled in a residency program, prepaid tuition, paid the STRF assessment, and suffered an economic loss as a result of any of the following:

1. The school closed before the course of instruction was completed.
2. The school's failure to pay refunds or charges on behalf a student to a third party for license fees or any other purpose, or to provide equipment or materials for which a charge was collected within 180 days before the closure of the school.
3. The school's failure to pay or reimburse loan proceeds under a federally guaranteed student loan program as required by law or to pay or reimburse proceeds received by the school prior to closure in excess of tuition and other costs.
4. There was a material failure to comply with the Act or this Division within 30days before the school closed or, if the material failure began earlier than 30days prior to closure, the period determined by the Bureau.
5. An inability after diligent efforts to prosecute, prove, and collect on a judgment against the institution for a violation of the Act.
